# Membership and Marketing: (Greg)

#### Safety & Safety Training:

## Payroll:

## Facilities & Grounds:

- Issues again with the Tractor, likely related to the re-gen mode for the emissions controls, however there have been other issues encountered. Greg will be following up with Stanton on the issues and what options we have.
  Joe has a documented list of issues.
- Grounds are very wet, mowing when we can. Various maintenance tasks are on hold until the fields dry out more.
  - If the fields are to be leveled out this will be a lengthy and costly service this should be considered after the expense for the indoor range.
- Norm asked about any lead reclamation efforts during this process Greg indicated the last effort was 7 years ago, and if we consider it, we'd want to include the FITASC fields.

# Old Business:

- Pistol Caliber Carbine Ben presented the roster list of RSO and a planned event on June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - This would be 2 pits. Go live at 10 and plan to wrap up by 3pm
  - Trial event, Ben will provide the 'marketing' information to Bob. Ben will also raise this during the steel match. Event will be capped at 20 shooters.
- Grading the parking log waiting for the grounds to dry out more before more work could be done to rectify the low spots.
